Competency:	13.1.3B Identify current personal interests.
Lesson Topic:	A Picture of Me
Subject:	Art, English
Length:	1 class period
Materials:	Large drawing paper, markers, and tape
Evaluation:	Students will portray themselves and what is most important to them through their artwork.

Procedure:

1. The teacher asks students to draw themselves.
2. The teacher asks students to draw three things that are important/interest them.
3. Have students share their artwork.

Competency:	13.1.3E Describe the work done by school personnel and other individuals in the community.
Lesson Topic:	Who Are the People In Your Neighborhood?
Subject:	Art, Social Studies
Length:	2 class period, homework
Materials:	Construction paper, crayons and pencils
Evaluation:	Students will identify work done by school personnel and others in their community.

Procedure:

1. Distribute construction paper, crayons, and pencils.
2. Ask students to draw a picture of someone who works in their school or someone they know who works in the community. Examples of these could be nurse, bus driver, gym teacher, police officer, daycare owner, etc.
3. Ask students to take their pictures home and in the space around the picture, write as many words they can think of that describe what that person does in their job.
4. Share homework assignment with the rest of the class and post in the classroom or hallway.
