



**Fifth Grade ▪ Career Retention and Advancement ▪ Math**

<b>Competency:</b>	<b>13.3.5D</b> Explain budgeting.
<b>Lesson Topic:</b>	House Budget
<b>Subject:</b>	Math
<b>Length:</b>	1 class period (homework assignment)
<b>Materials:</b>	Paper, pencil, crayons and Housing Budget worksheet
<b>Evaluation:</b>	Students will complete a housing budget as a homework assignment.

**Procedure:**

1. Teacher will distribute the *Housing Budget* worksheet to students for homework.
2. Students will work with their parents/guardians to fill in the cost of items in their households (This exercise will show how money is used).
3. Extra space is provided for additional household costs and space for students to comment on what they think about the cost of having a home.
4. Teacher leads class discussion on the importance of a budget and checks to make sure assignment was completed.

<b>Competency:</b>	<b>13.3.5F</b> Describe the impact of role changes at home, school, and at work, and how the role changes impact career advancement and retention.
<b>Lesson Topic:</b>	Roles
<b>Subject:</b>	Social Studies
<b>Length:</b>	Homework and class period
<b>Materials:</b>	Role Changes worksheet and pencil
<b>Evaluation:</b>	Students will recognize their roles change as they get older and that roles can play a part in careers.

**Procedure:**

1. Teacher discusses role changes in the home throughout history. This can include the women’s movement from stay at home moms to working mothers, working fathers to stay at home dads and how roles change as people age.
2. The teacher will distribute the *Role Changes* worksheet to students as a homework assignment.
3. Students will discuss the answers with the group and turn in the worksheet for credit.
